WHITE WINES		175ml Glass	Bottle
1. Colombard, Cotes de Gascogne, Plaimont, France	£5.00	£19.00	
Modern winemaking has allowed lively, fruit driven dry whites to be successfully produced from colombard. Un-oaked. 10.5% abv			
2. Pinot Grigio, Villa Benizi, Italy	£5.00	£19.00	
At last a Pinot Grigio that has both colour and flavour - the result of not being too greedy on quantity, preferring lower yields to capture all its potential. Un-oaked. 11.5% abv			
3. Sauvignon Blanc, Bruno Andreu, France	£5.00	£19.00	
Not always easy to achieve - lively acidity balanced to supple fruit flavours in the heat of southern France. However Bruno's Sauvignon is both a joy and a treat! 12.5% abv			
4. Murphys Big Rivers Un-oaked Chardonnay, Trentham Estate, Australia	£5.00	£19.00	
A lovely fresh glass of Chardonnay full of Aussie fruit without any interference by the use of oak. Un-oaked. 13.5% abv			
5. Loureiro Vila Nova, Vinho Verde, Portugal		£21.00	
Vinho Verde usually relies on the Albarino grape but here the Loureiro grape offers a step up in style and concentration. Delicious flinty minerality to enjoy as an aperitif or to match white meat dishes, fresh fish or seafood. Un-oaked. 12% abv			
6. Viognier, Aromo, Maule, Chile		£21.00	
A delicious full flavoured example of this elegant European variety - delightful aromatics herald a palate which is a joy to drink. 13% abv			
7. Chateau L'Ermitage Tradition Blanc, Costieres de Nimes, France		£22.00	
Roussane, Viognier and Grenache combine to produce a seductive and beautifully balanced dry white to partner fish, seafood and white meat dishes. Un-oaked. 13% abv			
8. Riesling, Pioneer Road, Clare Valley, Australia		£23.00	
The Clare Valley is home to some of Australia's finest dry rieslings - these styles are perfect for fish, white meats and lightly spicy dishes. 12% abv			
9. Chenin Blanc, Kaapzicht, Stellenbosch, South Africa		£23.00	
Thankfully the cape winegrowers have not pulled up all their chenin vines. Those that remain often have age and terrior to help them produce stunning styles - dry with supple fruit flavours. 13.5% abv			
10. Sauvignon Blanc, Honu, Marlborough, New Zealand		£23.00	
A classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, full and satisfying to taste with that crisp, refreshing, tropical Marlborough finish. 12.5% abv

11. Grenache/Syrah Rosé, Bruno Andreu, France	£5.00	£19.00	
At last a southern French rosé that has taken a leaf from the book of Provence. It's pale enticing colour is a hint towards a dry yet fruit driven style. 12.5% abv

12. Arena Negra, Merlot, Chile	£5.00	£19.00	
The supple fruit driven style of the Merlot grape has given it a licence to be enjoyed on any occasion, and the winemakers in Chile have been able to exploit this to the full and to our benefit. Un-oaked. 12.5% abv			
13. Murphys Big Rivers Shiraz, Trentham Estate, Australia	£5.00	£19.00	
Deep in colour with soft spicy fruit - the signature of the appealing nature of shiraz from Australia. Un-oaked. 14.5% abv			
14. Cielo Baccolo Appassimento Parziale, Veneto, Italy	£5.00	£19.00	
A satisfying mix of Merlot and Corvina grapes, partially dried to increase richness and intensity. Un-oaked. 12.5% abv			
15. Opta Red, Dao, Portugal		£20.00	
Dao is just one of a number of regions inside Portugal that is producing exciting red wines for everyday drinking. Un-oaked. 13% abv			
16. Organic Reserve de Fleur, Côtes du Rhône, France		£23.00	
Predominately a blend of Syrah and Grenache offering a soft spicy style supported by layers of fruit - a classic example of the welcoming style of red Rhône. 14.5% abv			
17. Beaujolais Villages rouge, Chateau de Belleverne, France		£22.00	
Belleverne own vineyards in St Amour, Julienas and Chenas, so it is no surprise that their entry level 'villages' wine has a wonderful pedigree and can show off the Gamay grape to its best character. Such a wine can be served gently chilled on a hot summer's day. Un-oaked 12.5% abv			
18. Ontanon Rioja, Crianza, Spain		£24.00	
The popularity of Rioja remains strong due to the smooth succulent marriage of Tempranillo and Graciano grapes. 13.5% abv			
19. Pinot Noir, Honu, New Zealand		£24.00	
Here is ample evidence that quality Pinot Noir can be accomplished outside Burgundy. Un-oaked. 13% abv			
20. DMZ Syrah, De Morgenzon, Stellenbosch, South Africa		£25.00	
A wonderful example, deep in colour with intense red fruit flavours and a touch of spice and integrated oak. 14.5% abv			
21. Tapiz Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina		£24.00	
Deep in colour with aromas of red berries and black fruit flavours - moulded with careful use of oak for maturation. 13.5% abv
